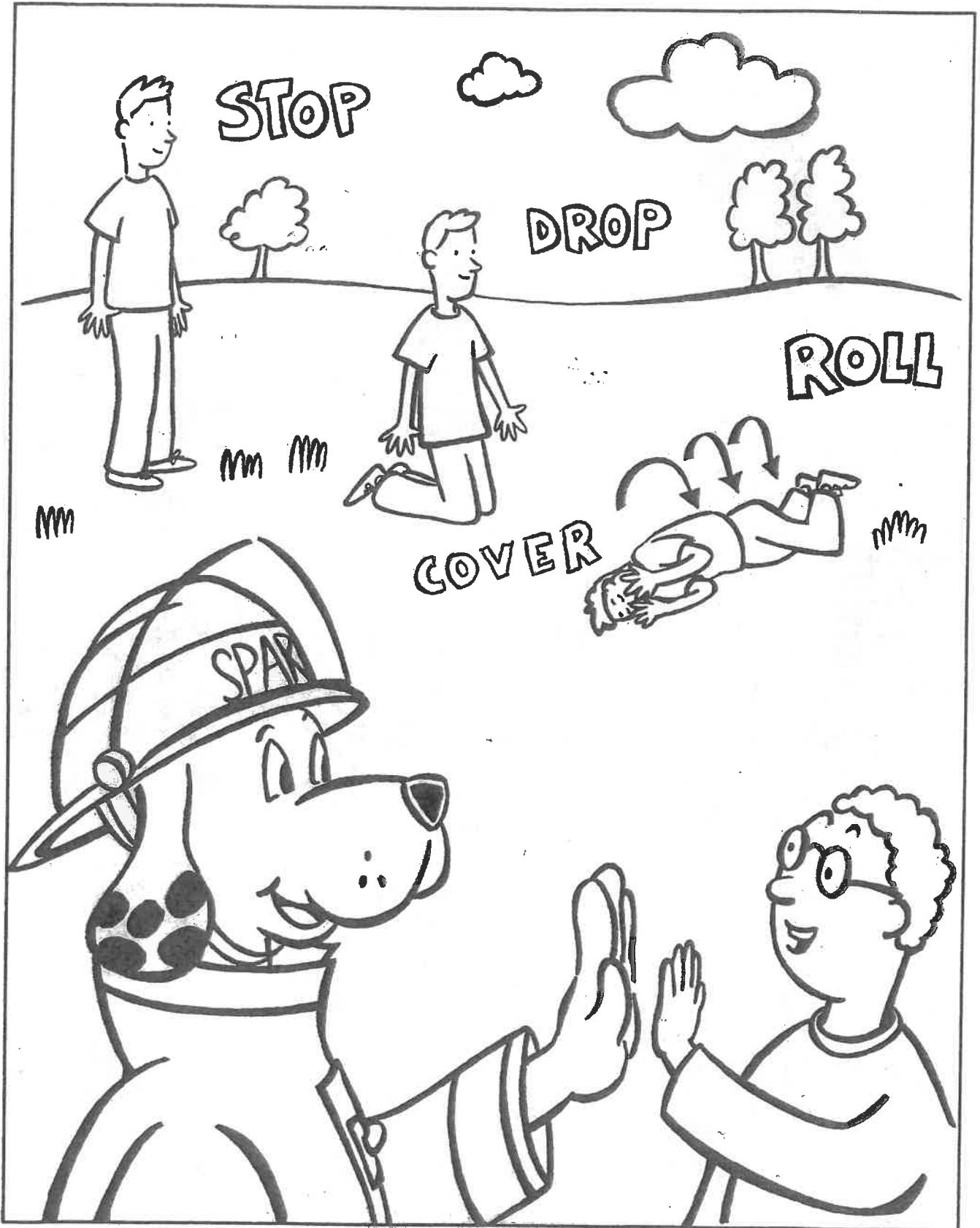

1. **STOP.** Running causes the flames to get bigger.
2. **DROP.** Use the ground to help put out flames.
3. **ROLL.** Smother the flames by rolling back and forth.
4. **COVER.** Protect your face and airway. (Fire burns upward.)

If your clothes catch fire, “Stop, Drop, Cover & Roll”!

1. STOP. Running causes flames to get bigger.
2. DROP. Use ground to help put out the flames.
3. COVER. Protect face & airway. (Fire burns upward.)
4. ROLL. Smother flames by rolling back and forth.

If your clothing catches on fire, you should

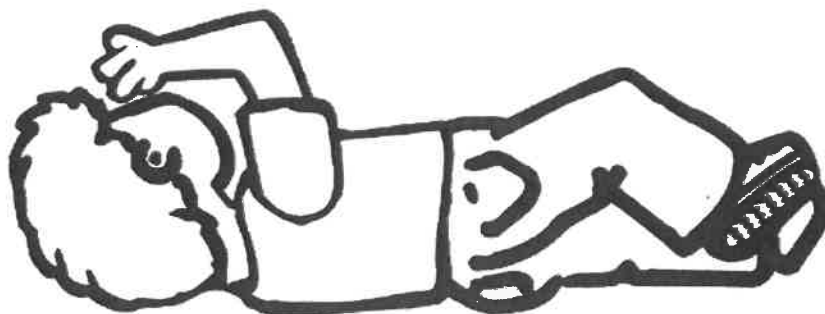
1. Stop where you are
