MEMEBERS ABSENT - Mallory Hillicoss & Uzette Grandison

We reviewed the Work Programs that were outlined the previous month.

- 1. Plant the Town Red- Cindy reported that she has spoken to the Garden Center at Lowe's and Russell's Farm Supply and they will be happy to guide shoppers in making plant choices that bloom RED and work for the customers gardening situation. Brian offered to help with flyers and Jordan is supplying a friend's name who can help with graphic design for a flyer. Cindy has made several Facebook posts to encourage residents and businesses to participate.
- 2. "C"—a landscaped bed with the Letter C. Lori has secured the O.K. From Collierville West Middle school principal for us to install a bed at that school on Frank Road side of campus. Greg says Town Beautiful can front the cost and install the initial bed IF the school agrees to maintain the bed after the initial installation. Lori will be confirming this, then we can move forward.
- 3. Tulip Festival- Melissa and Lori are doing legwork to see what we need to do on this. We will be working with Collierville Tourism on this and they have been out of pocket, so our representatives will be following up. Fall planting needs to take place to make a spring 2022 festival happen.
- 4. Dragon Statues- Jordan and Orpheus had some thoughts to share. Jordan gave several good arguments why the Dragon might not be the best idea for our statue plans. He suggested the commission look at a CLOCK like the clock in the Town Square and on the Town Logo. A vote was taken and a unanimous decision was reached to do further research on the feasibility of using a clock in the style of the Town Square Clock as our symbol to place around town.
