2. February 2023 meeting minutes approved as is.

Active Items

- 1. CEC Student Member Solicitation for 2023-2024 school year
 - a. **Paul / Clay** confirm details to ensure we advertise this to have the Mayor and Board choose a new member in April, so the new member can attend the May meeting.
- 2. Fair on the Square May 6&7, 2023
 - a. Pamphlets
 - i. 4 left over from last year:
 - a. Native plants/butterflies

 - ii. Create 2 new ones:

7. Recycling Education

- a. Goal reduce contamination.
- b. General plan:
 - i. Pick one elementary school to go to each Friday (5 schools, 5 Fridays)
 - ii. Focus only on one grade to keep the group small and keep the kid's attention (3rd, 4th or 5th?)
 - iii. Take the recycle truck, allow students to look and ask questions.
 - iv. Kids work in teams on a game regarding what you can/cannot recycle. Have clean items for kids to sort into a trash bin vs a recycle bin.
 - v. Send fliers home for a contest for kids to commit to recycling, must have their parents sign it. Class that gets the most signed papers returned wins a pizza party.
